COATS FOR KIDS: Provides new coats to disadvantaged and at-risk children who are in need a of winter coat. Our Council distributes coats to children living in Maryland and in Pakistan.

PREGNANCY CENTER NORTH: Provides free pregnancy-related services for women in the Baltimore community. OB ultrasounds, pregnancy testing, counseling, support groups, referrals & material aid.

K of C MD. STATE RELIEF: Offers charitable assistance to those in need throughout Maryland.

ST. ELIZABETH SCHOOL: A co-educational, nonpublic school program offering academic, social/emotional development, and vocational instruction to students ages 6-21 with various disabilities .

MISSIONARY SISTERS OF CHARITY: The Sisters strive to meet the spiritual, emotional and physical needs of the indigent in East Baltimore through prayer, food, housing, clothing and joy.

CAMP-GLOW: Offers a free week long of residential summer camp experience for adults with disabilities that fosters a loving and spiritual environment.

ACTC & UCAN: A consortium of churches providing emergency help (food, rent assistance, etc) for those in need in Baltimore County & northern Baltimore City.

SISTERS ACADEMY: This tuition-free middle-school educates disadvantaged girls, offering an academic program that encourages each student's intellectual, social, physical, and spiritual development.

BICYCLE PROGRAM: Donated bicycles are refurbished by council members and other volunteers. Repairs are funded by the Charity enabling the bikes to be donated to those in need of transportation regardless of age.

FRANCISCAN CENTER: Provides assistance and numerous outreach programs including a daily meal to persons who are economically disadvantaged, in an effort to maintain & dignity as people of God.
